## **Top Tips**

### **Face Masks**

If you suffer from MCS sooner or later you are going to find yourself entertaining ideas of buying a protective face mask – even if just for emergencies.

Initially my own experience with these MCS aids was not at all good. I invariably found that the mask I had just bought either didn't fit very well, looked terrible, made me feel like I was suffocating when it was on, made me ill by itself just by wearing it, or just plain didn't seem to work; sometimes even all of the above!

Finally I found an MCS Mask that really solved all of those problems: The "AERO Mask" made by UK company Respro. Snug fit with built in deformable nose clip, twin exhalation valves, firm Velcro fastening, replaceable inner MCS filters - and all wrapped up in a sporty kind of look. Worth Checking.

### **Healthy Eating**

The importance of proper nutrition can never be over-emphasized – especially when you suffer from a combination of ME and MCS. However, while fresh fruit and veg are always right up there on the health list, they are often very difficult to tolerate for MCS sufferers (impossible for some) due to the toxic chemical residues present on them. This, of course, can make for further deterioration in ones health.

So, what can be done about it? Having tried various washing and steeping strategies with only very limited success I finally found a reliable method for detoxing all my fruit and vegetables: A water ozonator! (Google it - or phone me if interested).

I simply put my fruit/veg into a large bowl (or even the kitchen sink), cover with water, insert my water ozonator into the mix - and switch on. 15 minutes later all chemical residues have been neutralized and once again you can enjoy lettuce, cabbage and strawberries in season. Even better, once treated like this the fruit/veg will stay fresher for much longer!

#### **Cavity Wall Insulation**

I've had ME for 14 yrs, severely for 12. I used to work as a town planner dealing with applications for houses etc, often I'd work with building inspectors from the council. I thought I'd probably never have much to do with buildings again until this year.

I moved into a bungalow in my parents village within 2 wks I began getting migraines, I couldn't use my computer, my eyes couldn't bear the brightness..... even the white painted rooms became a problem, my eyes at times would go blind as they can when you have a migraine. This was due to build up of rubbish/toxins in my body...

Though drinking lemon juice and water in large quantities helped (ie. to flush the build up of toxins in my kidneys and liver it did not solve the problem at all). In all my years of severe ME I'd never experienced anything so severe as this. But it was obvious it was the bungalow. I now know it as when I moved back to my parents house all these symptoms went.

The bungalow was built in the 1970s and cavity wall insulation was installed. In the 1970s cavity wall insulation was used in many properties to fill up the cavity gap in new or old properties.

This particular type of CWI was banned in the late 1970s as people, even those without MCS or ME began to feel unwell, my building inspector friends told me recently. But the majority of it remains in homes across the country.

The CWI in question outgases formaldrahyde (even 30 or 40 years after it was installed) which is a harmful chemical. Although it doesn't usually affect healthy people, it will affect people who have a low tolerance to it, eg. those who have ME or MCS for example. My ME/CFS Specialist, Dr Sarah Myhill, gave me this information and has supported me in getting the council to move me to another property.

Hope this may help some of you.
